

# Analysis of the usage of 'Jesus' and 'Christ' in the New Testament

## New Testament usage

Adjusting the figures for Romans to Jude where "Jesus" occurs in close proximity to a title changes these figures to:

## People addressing Christ as "Jesus"

There are only four incidents where the Lord Jesus is ever addressed as 'Jesus'. Even in these cases, a great deal of honour is shown.

### 1) Man with unclean spirit

**Mark 1:24** saying, What do we have to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are-- the Holy One of God!

**Luke 4:34** Ha! What do we have to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are- the Holy One of God!

### 2) Gaderene demoniac

**Mark 5:7** and crying out with a loud voice, he said, What do I have to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I implore You by God, do not torment me!

**Luke 8:28** And seeing Jesus, he cried out and fell before Him, and said in a loud voice, What do I have to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I beg You, do not torment me.

### 3) Ten lepers

**Luke 17:13** and they raised their voices, saying, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!

### 4) Blind Bartimaeus (called him Rabboni in v51)

**Mark 10:47** And when he heard that it was Jesus the Nazarene, he began to cry out and say, Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!

**Luke 18:38** And he called out, saying, Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!

## Occurrences of "Jesus" without a title from Acts to Revelation

**Acts 1:1** The former treatise have I made O Theophilus of all that **Jesus** began both to do and teach

**Acts 1:11** Which also said Ye men of Galilee why stand ye gazing up into heaven this same **Jesus** which is taken up from you into heaven shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven

**Acts 1:14** These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication with the women and Mary the mother of **Jesus** and with his brethren

**Acts 1:16** Men and brethren this scripture must needs have been fulfilled which the Holy Ghost by the mouth of David spake before concerning Judas which was guide to them that took **Jesus**

- Acts 2:22** Ye men of Israel hear these words **Jesus** of Nazareth a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs which God did by him in the midst of you as ye yourselves also know
- Acts 2:32** This **Jesus** hath God raised up whereof we all are witnesses
- Acts 2:36** Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God hath made that same **Jesus** whom ye have crucified both Lord and Christ
- Acts 3:13** The God of Abraham and of Isaac and of Jacob the God of our fathers hath glorified his Son **Jesus** whom ye delivered up and denied him in the presence of Pilate when he was determined to let him go
- Acts 3:26** Unto you first God having raised up his Son **Jesus** sent him to bless you in turning away every one of you from his iniquities
- Acts 4:2** Being grieved that they taught the people and preached through **Jesus** the resurrection from the dead
- Acts 4:13** Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men they marvelled and they took knowledge of them that they had been with **Jesus**
- Acts 4:18** And they called them and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of **Jesus**
- Acts 4:27** For of a truth against thy holy child **Jesus** whom thou hast anointed both Herod and Pontius Pilate with the Gentiles and the people of Israel were gathered together
- Acts 4:30** By stretching forth thine hand to heal and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child **Jesus**
- Acts 5:30** The God of our fathers raised up **Jesus** whom ye slew and hanged on a tree
- Acts 5:40** And to him they agreed and when they had called the apostles and beaten them they commanded that they should not speak in the name of **Jesus** and let them go
- Acts 6:14** For we have heard him say that this **Jesus** of Nazareth shall destroy this place and shall change the customs which Moses delivered us
- Acts 7:45** Which also our fathers that came after brought in with **Jesus** into the possession of the Gentiles whom God drove out before the face of our fathers unto the days of David
- Acts 7:55** But he being full of the Holy Ghost looked up stedfastly into heaven and saw the glory of God and **Jesus** standing on the right hand of God
- Acts 8:35** Then Philip opened his mouth and began at the same scripture and preached unto him **Jesus**
- Acts 9:5** And he said Who art thou Lord And the Lord said I am **Jesus** whom thou persecutest it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks
- Acts 9:17** And Ananias went his way and entered into the house and putting his hands on him said Brother Saul the Lord even **Jesus** that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest hath sent me that thou mightest receive thy sight and be filled with the Holy Ghost
- Acts 9:27** But Barnabas took him and brought him to the apostles and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way and that he had spoken to him and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of **Jesus**
- Acts 10:38** How God anointed **Jesus** of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power who went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed of the devil for God was with him
- Acts 13:23** Of this mans seed hath God according to his promise raised unto Israel a Saviour **Jesus**
- Acts 13:33** God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children in that he hath raised up **Jesus** again as it is also written in the second psalm Thou art my Son this day have I begotten thee
- Acts 17:3** Opening and alleging that Christ must needs have suffered and risen again from the dead and that this **Jesus** whom I preach unto you is Christ
- Acts 17:7** Whom Jason hath received and these all do contrary to the decrees of Caesar saying that there is another king one **Jesus**
- Acts 17:18** Then certain philosophers of the Epicureans and of the Stoicks encountered him And some said What will this babbler say other some He seemeth to be a setter forth of strange gods because he preached unto them **Jesus** and the resurrection
- Acts 18:5** And when Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia Paul was pressed in the spirit and testified to the Jews that **Jesus** was Christ
- Acts 18:28** For he mightily convinced the Jews and that publicly shewing by the scriptures that **Jesus** was Christ
- Acts 19:13** Then certain of the vagabond Jews exorcists took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord **Jesus** saying We adjure you by **Jesus** whom Paul preacheth
- Acts 19:15** And the evil spirit answered and said **Jesus** I know and Paul I know but who are ye
- Acts 22:8** And I answered Who art thou Lord And he said un to me I am **Jesus** of Nazareth whom thou persecutest
- Acts 25:19** But had certain questions against him of their own superstition and of one **Jesus** which was dead whom Paul affirmed to be alive
- Acts 26:9** I verily thought with myself that I ought to do many things contrary to the name of **Jesus** of Nazareth
- Acts 26:15** And I said Who art thou Lord And he said I am **Jesus** whom thou persecutest
- Acts 28:23** And when they had appointed him a day there came many to him into his lodging to whom he expounded and testified the kingdom of God persuading them concerning **Jesus** both out of the law of Moses and out of the prophets from morning till evening

**Rom 3:26** To declare I say at this time his righteousness that he might be just and the justifier of him which believeth in **Jesus**

**Rom 4:24** But for us also to whom it shall be imputed if we believe on him that raised up **Jesus** our Lord from the dead

**Rom 8:11** But if the Spirit of him that raised up **Jesus** from the dead dwell in you he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you

**1Co 12:3** Wherefore I give you to understand that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth **Jesus** accursed and that no man can say that **Jesus** is the Lord but by the Holy Ghost

**2Co 4:5** For we preach not ourselves but Christ **Jesus** the Lord and ourselves your servants for **Jesus** sake

**2Co 4:10** Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord **Jesus** that the life also of **Jesus** might be made manifest in our body

**2Co 4:11** For we which live are always delivered unto death for **Jesus** sake that the life also of **Jesus** might be made manifest in our mortal flesh

**2Co 4:14** Knowing that he which raised up the Lord **Jesus** shall raise up us also by **Jesus** and shall present us with you

**2Co 11:4** For if he that cometh preacheth another **Jesus** whom we have not preached or if ye receive another spirit which ye have not received or another gospel which ye have not accepted ye might well bear with him

**Eph 4:21** If so be that ye have heard him and have been taught by him as the truth is in **Jesus**

**Phil 2:10** That at the name of **Jesus** every knee should bow of things in heaven and things in earth and things under the earth

**1Th 1:10** And to wait for his Son from heaven whom he raised from the dead even **Jesus** which delivered us from the wrath to come

**1Th 4:14** For if we believe that **Jesus** died and rose again even so them also which sleep in **Jesus** will God bring with him

**Heb 2:9** But we see **Jesus** who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honour that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man

**Heb 4:14** Seeing then that we have a great high priest that is passed into the heavens **Jesus** the Son of God let us hold fast our profession

**Heb 6:20** Whither the forerunner is for us entered even **Jesus** made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec

**Heb 7:22** By so much was **Jesus** made a surety of a better testament

**Heb 10:19** Having therefore brethren boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of **Jesus**

**Heb 12:2** Looking unto **Jesus** the author and finisher of our faith who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross despising the shame and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God

**Heb 12:24** And to **Jesus** the mediator of the new covenant and to the blood of sprinkling that speaketh better things than that of Abel

**Heb 13:12** Wherefore **Jesus** also that he might sanctify the people with his own blood suffered without the gate

**2Pe 1:2** Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God and of **Jesus** our Lord

**1Jn 2:22** Who is a liar but he that denieth that **Jesus** is the Christ He is antichrist that denieth the Father and the Son

**1Jn 4:15** Whosoever shall confess that **Jesus** is the Son of God God dwelleth in him and he in God

**1Jn 5:1** Whosoever believeth that **Jesus** is the Christ is born of God and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him

**1Jn 5:5** Who is he that overcometh the world but he that believeth that **Jesus** is the Son of God

**Rev 1:9** I John who also am your brother and companion in tribulation and in the kingdom and patience of **Jesus** Christ was in the isle that is called Patmos for the word of God and for the testimony of **Jesus** Christ

**Rev 14:12** Here is the patience of the saints here are they that keep the commandments of God and the faith of **Jesus**

**Rev 17:6** And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints and with the blood of the martyrs of **Jesus** and when I saw her I wondered with great admiration

**Rev 19:10** And I fell at his feet to worship him And he said unto me See thou do it not I am thy fellowservant and of thy brethren that have the testimony of **Jesus** worship God for the testimony of **Jesus** is the spirit of prophecy

**Rev 20:4** And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of **Jesus**, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

**Rev 22:16** I **Jesus** have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches I am the root and the offspring of David and the bright and morning star
